NOTICE OF RACE

Two Island Sail & Run

Saturday 8th July 2017

Port Douglas Yacht Club Inc, the organizing authority, invites entries to compete in the 2017 Two Island Sail & Run.

1. Rules

1.1 The Race will be governed by the rules, as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017 – 2020, the Prescriptions of Yachting Australia (YA), and the Special Regulations of YA - Addendum A - Category 6, and the Supplementary Sailing Instructions (SSI).

2. The Course

2.1 Stage 1: Port Douglas to Low Isles return. Stage 2: Approx. 5.4km run including 250m swim - PDYC to QT Resort and return.

3. Divisions.

3.1 Entries race in Division 1 using an allocated handicap for boats.

4. Conditions of entry.

4.1 Entries must be submitted on official entry forms available at PDYC.

4.2 The closing date for entries is 6pm Wednesday 5th July.

4.3 Each vessel shall nominate one crew member to be the athlete for Stage 2.

4.4 Each vessel shall have public liability insurance, not less than A\$5 million.

4.5 By entering the owner/charterer agrees to be bound by the RRS, Notice of Race and the SSI.

5 Race Briefing

5.1 8:30AM at PDYC Saturday 8th July 2017.

6. Sailing Instructions

6.1 Supplementary Sailing Instructions and Athlete Instructions will be posted on the club notice board and website prior to the event, and be available at the race briefing.

7. Schedule of Racing

7.1 Stage 1: Start 10:15. Stage 2: Start ASAP after each boat finishes stage 1.

8. Prizes

8.1 To be announced at presentation inclusive of 1st, 2nd and 3rd on handicap, line honours overall and fastest athlete.

8.2 Presentation of prizes will follow conclusion of racing at Port Douglas Yacht Club.

8.3 Points do not count towards Club Championship.

9. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk. See RRS, Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.
