NOTICE OF RACE

Coral Sea Cup Regatta

Saturday 14th & Sunday 15th October 2017

Port Douglas Yacht Club Inc, the organizing authority, invites entries to compete in the 2017 Coral Sea Cup.

1. Rules

1-1 The Race will be governed by the rules, as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017 – 2020, the Prescriptions of Yachting Australia (YA), and the Special Regulations of YA - Addendum A - Category 6, and the Supplementary Sailing Instructions (SSI).

2. Courses

2-1 Three races over two days including one long race and two short races.

3. Divisions.

3-1 All boats race in one division using the performance handicap system (PHS).

4. Conditions of entry.

4-1 Entries may be made by email or in person by notifying the Sailing Committee of intention to compete.

4-2 It is a condition of entry that each vessel shall have legal public liability insurance, of not less than A\$5 million.

4-3 By nominating to enter the owner/charterer agrees to be bound by the RRS, Notice of Race and SSI.

5. Supplementary Sailing Instructions, (SSI) will be issued prior to the race briefing.

6. Schedule of Races.

6-1 Race 1: Warning signal will be at 1025 on Saturday 14th October 2017.

Race 2: Warning signal will be ASAP after conclusion of first race.

Race 3: Warning signal will be at 1010 on Sunday 15th October 2017.

6-2 The schedule of races may change depending on the forecast conditions.

7. Prizes

7-1 Boats race for the Coral Sea Cup Trophy (to remain at PDYC) plus handicap honours 1st, 2nd and 3rd.

7-2 Presentation of prizes will follow conclusion of racing at Port Douglas Yacht Club.

8. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk. See RRS, Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.
